

- (3) FSCC, Bethalion Command Sproup, maintains active target list to include separately designated suspect or confirmed hostile morter positions as determined.

b. Restricted Targets

- (1) Every effort will be made to preserve religious, cultural, medical and public installations.
- (2) Supporting sums fires into populated areas are restricted to those instances wherein the commander deems it necessary in order to prevent friendly casualties and to accomplish his mission.

5. AIRCRAFT SANETY

a. Sentries and Lookouts

- (1) Air sentries will be posted at artillery and mortar positions to insome rafety of friendly aircraft.
- (2) Particular attention will be paid to the approach and retirement lawer of aircraft operation at the airfield adjacent to the command post, battalion command group.
- (3) Forward observers while directing supporting arms shall insure the safety of friendly aircraft.

b. Restrictive Fire Plan

- (1) In accordance with reference (c). To be implemented by the commander, Battalion Command Group, if the situation so dictates.
- (2) All aircraft entering into battalion operation area are required to contact FSCC, Battalion Semmend Group, for location of supporting arms fire missions in progress. Annex F (Air Operations).
- (3) Every effort must be made to coordinate helicopter Med Evac's and supporting arms fires attacking active hostile targets.

Ground commanders may impose restrictive plans on aircraft and/ or supporting arms fire as deemed appropriate.

c. Flak Sunpression Fires

- (1) An aggressive flak suppression program will be implemented. Prestrike and staiks filter will be employed when appropriate. Suspected targets, as well as targets of opportunity, will be engaged on a priority basis.
- (2) Refer to Annex B (Intellagence), to current ISUMS and to target information for confirmed and suspected locations of flak suppression targets.
- (3) Selection, econdination and implementation of flak suppression fixed are accomplished in the MSCC, Battalion Command Group. Such requires the closest listson to include integratelom of effecting and observation agencies.

6. SAFETY OF GROUND PORCES

a. Fire Coordination Line

- (1) Used to regulate all supporting fires and air strikes on either side of said line. No such fires will be requested or delivered across the fire coordination line without the approval of the cognizant commander.
- (2) Fire coordination line established to coincide with the boundary of the battalion operating area as depicted in Annex D (Operation, Overlay).
- b. Troop Safety. FSCC, Battalion Command Group, effects liaison with friendly forces within battalion operation area to insure troop sefety. Appendix 2 (Friendly ARVN Units) to Annex D (Operation Overlay).



1. SITUATION

- a. Enemy forces. See current ISUM's and special intelligence reports as issued.
- b. Friendly forces. FMAW provides 3 UH-34D or 2 CH-46A troop helicopters escerted by either 1 or 2 armed UH-1E aircraft.
- 2. MISSION. 9th Marines' mission of outlined in reference (b) remains unchanged. To facilitate execution of its mission, 9th Marines maintains a reinforced rifle squad with each forward battalion on daylight alort for immediate deployment by helicopter to any destination in its zone of action to exploit contact with hestile forces.

3. EXECUTION

a. Concept of Operation

- (1) Each forward infantry battalion maintains a SPARROW
 HAWK squad which is on immediate alent for possible
 employment within or immediately adjacent to its
 own arms of action. The STARROW HAWK squad is transported
 to the objective area by UH-34D or CH-46A helicopters
 escorted by armed UH-14 aircraft.
- (2) SPARROW HAWK squad lands in rear or on the enemy's flank. It is utilized as a separate maneuver element on the ground either in a mobile role or as a blocking force. The SPARROW HAWK squad is not normally employed as a reinforcing element.

SPICEFI

(3) Upon insertion, SPARROW HAWK aircraft return to Marble Mountain Air Facility to await orders to retract the squad or to execute another SPARROW HAWK mission. Because of familiarity with their own zone of action, 9th Marines SPARROW HAWK squads frequently retract by foot march instead of by helicopter.

b. Coordinating Instructions

- (1) Requirements. Forward infantry battalions will maintain at least one reinforced rifle squad on immediate alert at predesignated pickup LZ during daylight hours.
- (2) Composition of SPARROW HAWK Squad. SPARROW HAWK squads will be composed of 21 troops maximum when employed with 3 UH-34D aircraft. 3 to 5 additional personnel may be added to the SPARROW HAWK squad when 2 CH-46A aircraft are used in lieu of 3 UH-34D s.
- (3) Pestrictions. SPARROW HARK missions are restricted to daylight hours (0700H 1900H).
- (4) <u>Driefing</u>. Insure clear and concise tactical briefings. Pilots will be briefed while enroute to pickup LZ; infantry units will be briefed prior to deployment.

(5) Requesting Procedures.

- (a) Requests for SPARROW HAWK missions will be submitted directly to DASC by requesting battalion.
- (b) Requests for SPARROW HAWK rehearsals will be submitted to this Headquarters which will coordinate with DASC to insure that rehearsal missions are not executed at the expense of actual missions.
- (c) Format for requesting CPAEROW HAVE missions:
 - 1. ALPHA: Pickup coordinates.
 - 2. BRAVO: Destination coordinates.
 - 3. CHARLIE: Location of enemy.
 - 4. Description of enemy.
 - 5. ECHO: Location of friendly forces.
 - 6. FOXTROT: Gold skew and radio frequency of requesting battalion.
 - 7. GOLF: Remarks.

- (6) Helicopter Utilization
 - (a) SPARROW HAWK helicopters will not normally be retained after insertion of the SPARROW HAWK squad but will be released to return to MMAF to await instructions to retract squad or to be employed in other SPARROW HAWK missions.
 - (b) Under unusual circumstances, SPARROW HAWK aircraft may be retained in area to insert additional personnel; however, this may be done only with the specific approval of this Headquarters.
- (7) Unclassified Code Name. SPARROW HAWK.
- (8) Liaison. Direct liaison between commanders authorized.
- 4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS.
 - a. Logistics. SPARROW HAWK squad members carry a minimum of 1 MCI and BA ammunition per individual.
- 5. COMMAND AND COMMUNICATION ELECTRONICS
 - a. Communication Electronics
 - (I) Request SPARROW HAWK missions to DASC (Landshark) on the Tactical Air Request (TAR) #1 net.
 - (2) Contact with SPARROW HAWK squad will be made on battalion tactical net by the Helicopter Flight Leader.
 - (3) Battalion Commanders will insure that they have capability to monitor control nets and will ascertain that all participating units can net on a given frequency.
 - (4) Call signs.
 - (a) SPARROW HAWK 1: Infantry unit.
 - (b) SPARROW HAWK 2: UH-34D's/CH-46A's.
 - (c) SPARROW HAWK 3: UH-LE's.

(5) Pyrotechnics

- (a) Red Smoke: Receiving enemy fire/unsecure LZ.
- (b) Green smoke: Friendly troops/secure LZ.
- (c) White phosphorus: Enemy position.
- (d) Green star cluster: Friendly position.
- (e) Yellow smoke: Med Evac LZ.


Subj: Evaluation of Force Requirements

- 1. Reference (a) as modified by reference (b) requested an evaluation of force requirements with a view toward eliminating or reducing forces or elements which are not needed or which might be replaced by units of greater usefulness.
- 2. The comments which follow are the consensus of the opinions of the regimental commander and the commanders of the five infantry battalions now serving with the 9th Marines. It should be noted that these comments specifically pertain to the current environment and combat situation and do not constitute a recommendation for a restructuring of existing tables of organization. Also, this should not be considered an exhaustive or definitive study.
- 3. Headquarters Company, Marine Regiment. Satisfactory.
- 4. Headquarters/Service Company, Infantry Battalion.
- a. 106mm Recoilless Rifle Platoon. The 106mm rifle is not a useful weapon in this environment. Two battalion commanders felt it would be useful if there were an antipersonnel canister round. One battalion commander recommended the substitution of the 57mm recoilless rifle for the 106mm.

Recommendation. That the battalions be permitted to place all or part of their 106mm rifles in storage at FISG (A).



b. Flamethrower Section. Consensus was that the flame-throwers were of limited use.

Recommendation. That the battalions be permitted to place part of their flamethrowers in storage at FISG (A).

5. Rifle Company, Infantry Battalion

a. 60mm Mortar Section. The 60mm mortar has proved itself valuable in this environment. The 60mm mortar section, however, continues to be a provisional organization.

Recommendation. In absence of a T/O change, the manning level of the rifle companies should recognize the requirement to provide personnel for the 60mm mortar section.

b. Assault Section. The M-72 LAAW has largely taken the place of the 3.5-inch rocket launcher. Chief use of the 3.5-inch rocket launcher is with the white phosphorus round.

Recommendation. If a white phosphorus round were developed for the M-72 MAAW; the 3.5-inch rocket lauraber could be eliminated. As the M-72 does not require an assistant gunner, the size of the assault section could be reduced by six individuals.

c. Machine Gun Section. Certain of the battalion commanders indicated a requirement for a fourth machine gun squad for a total of eight M-60s in the rifle company.

Recommendation. Add a fourth machine gun squad to the machine gun section.

- 6. AN/TFS-21. There was general agreement that the AN/TFS-21 ("Tipsy 21") was not useful and should be eliminated.
- 7. <u>LWTs</u>. There was general agreement that the LWT served adequately as a resupply vehicle, performed marginally as an armored personnel carrier, and was unsatisfactory as a river patrol craft.
- 8. Artillery. Possible requirement exists for additional light artillery battalions for the direct support role. Artillery support was considered satisfactory in all respects except for the shortage of forward observers.
- 9. Tanks. It was agreed that the M-48 was a useful although expensive, gun and searchlight platform. It is also useful as a maneuver element in those areas permitting its employment. It was realized that a lighter tank could serve these purposes as well or better, but it was recognized that it would



be infeasible to re-equip the tank battalion with lighter armor.

- 10. Ontos. The ontos has limited value as a convoy escort vehicle. The limitations stated for the 106mm rifle also, of course, pertain to the ontos. It is believed that the Antitank Battalion could be re-equipped profitably with tracted vehicles mounting quad fifties and dual forties.
- 11. Motor Transport. The value of the 5-ton six-by-six truck in this environment (poor roads, limited bridges, etc.) was questioned.
- 12. Engineers. Because of the requirement for roads, bridges, water points, mines and mine-clearing, it is recommended that a minimum of one engineer company and preferably an engineer battalion be placed in direct support of each infantry regiment.
